## Dear Committee Members:

On April 14, 2006, I attended the Supreme Court's Advisory Committee meeting and spoke regarding process service. At one point, I referred to Mr. Alex Londoff as a process server who is under investigation by the Process Server Review Board (PSRB). As I stated, Mr. Londoff is not certified by the Supreme Court and has not applied to become certified. This directly contradicts the testimony of the PSRB Chariman, Carl Weeks, who stated that the PSRB does not investigate process servers that are not certified or who have not applied to become certified. When speaking about Mr. Londoff, I informed the Committee that he pled no contest to a crime and was currently on deferred adjudication, which is correct. I also stated that Mr. Londoff is currently on probation, which is incorrect. Mr. Londoff is not on probation. I apologize for the confusion. Regardless, Mr. Londoff has not been convicted of the crime in question as claimed by Chairman Weeks. Furthermore, I am in receipt of written confirmation that the PSRB still has an active investigation pending on Mr. Londoff, weeks after the April 14<sup>th</sup> meeting, despite Chairman Weeks' claim that the PSRB does not investigate non-certified process servers.

I simply wanted to clarify my statements regarding Mr. Londoff. Thank you.
