## 34.6 Reporter's Record

(a) Contents

## (b) Request for Preparaton

(1) At or before the time for perfecting the appeal [in the court of appeals or within \_\_\_\_ [e.g. 5] days after the date on which the parties are directed to obtain the preparation of the reporter's record in a direct appeal under Rule 57], the appellant must request in writing that the official reporter prepare the reporter's record. The request must designate the exhibits to be included. A request to the court reporter – but not the court recorder – must also designate the portions of the proceedings to be included.
